What's The Cost To Build A Tabernacle?

"And this is the contribution that you shall receive from them: gold, silver, and bronze, blue and purple and scarlet yarns and fine twined linen, goats' hair, tanned rams' skins, goatskins, acacia wood, oil for the lamps, spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense, onyx stones, and stones for setting, for the ephod and for the breastpiece"(Ex 25:3-7)

Consider the list that Moses was given to share with Israel. This list represents the material needed for the construction of the tabernacle. It's considerably different to a list that we would have if we were building a house or even the materials used to build structures like the wall of Jerusalem recorded in the book of Nehemiah. The precious materials chosen by God for His dwelling place teach us that the tabernacle, though a simple structure, had great significance.

The design of the tabernacle taught Israel the value of being in communion with God. Since the relationship that God shared with the Israel was special, so was the place where this relationship was memorialized through offerings and sacrifices.

As New Testament Israel God does not invite us to build a tabernacle or temple for His dwelling but he says that we are this temple and that we are bought with a price(1 Cor 3: 16; 6:19). He invites us to allow Him to dwell in us. God's tabernacle today are living stones, Christians who have heard, understood and obeyed the gospel. Since a soul is priceless, the cost of building this temple is innumerable. Like Israel, however, the value and significance of this temple should affect how we give toward it. Like Israel, let's give until God says there's enough. Like Israel, let's remember that we are God's special people who have been called to God's special purpose. Like Israel, let's remember that the value of our relationship with God is manifested in our giving.

While we do not know the exact cost of the tabernacle or temple in the Old Testament, our spiritual temple is invaluable. Let's build it!

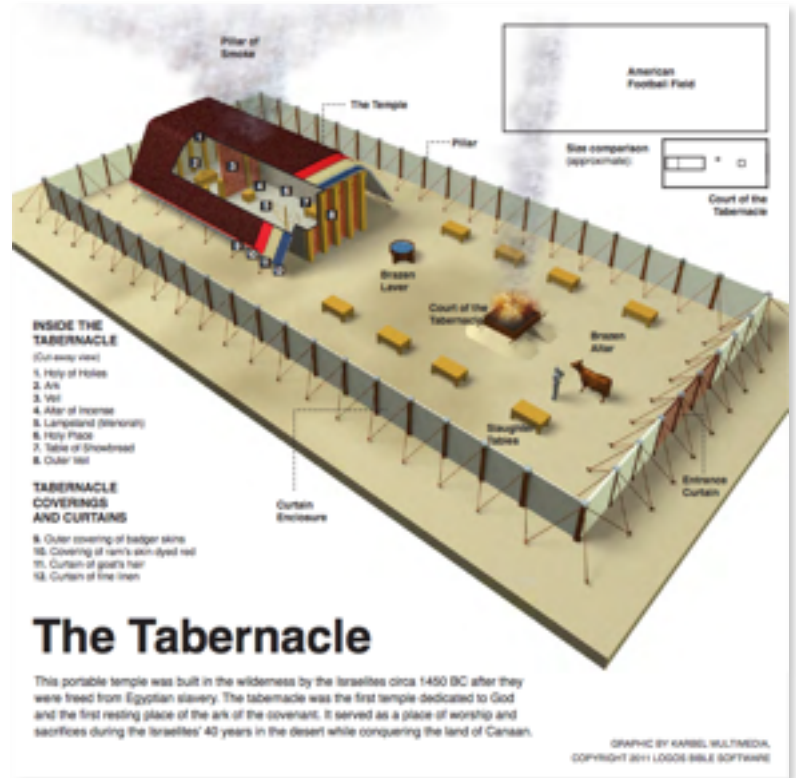
