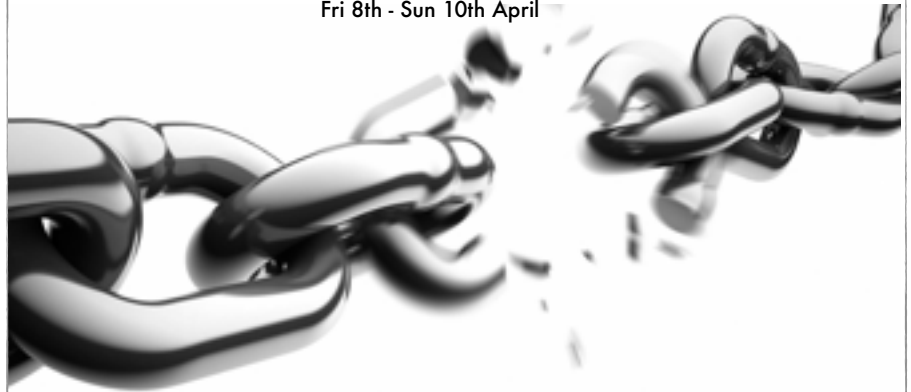

## God Is Worthy

When in the presence of dignitaries it is required that we show respect that is due. We do so by respectful and appropriate behavior and by observing established protocol.

When a person(including world leaders) meets the queen of England there is a long list of protocols that guides one's behavior in the presence of "Her Majesty". One such is the "no touch" rule. The queen's visitors must wait until she extends her hand to take it. Even then they aren't supposed to grip tightly or pump it. A person is forbidden from hugging, kissing on the cheek and touching the queen's shoulder.
