Out With Doubt

Yet they sinned still more against him,
rebellng against the Most High in the desert.

They tested God in their heart
by demanding the food they craved.

They spoke against God, saying,
“Can God spread a table in the wilderness?

He struck the rock so that water gushed out
and streams overflowed.

Can he also give bread
or provide meat for his people?”

Therefore, when the Lord heard, he was full of wrath;
a fire was kindled against Jacob;

his anger rose against Israel,
because they did not believe in God

and did not trust his saving power. - Psalms 78:17-22

As the inspired shepherd reiterates some of Israel's antiquity, he highlights a period of unbelief among God's people. They challenged the Divine Provision of the all-sufficient God and doubted his ability to take care of his own children. Israel's malady is reflective of man's own weakness to doubt a caring and sovereign God, even today. Doubt is undoubtedly the unstable ground on which unbelief is built. As Israel questioned God in the wilderness, are we doing the same today in what is our wilderness? Paul confronts the issue of doubt in a very straightforward manner when he says in Romans 14:22-23, “The faith that you have, keep between yourself and God. Blessed is the one who has no reason to pass judgment on himself for what he approves. But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.” Paul points out that doubting is not of faith and then that it is sin. Clearly doubting in God is opposed to God and his will. It is sinful because it questions God's character and abilities. God can be trusted because of his track record. As children of God we should be out with doubt !
